

Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC) Qualification Checklist

CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY NOW AND GET YOUR MULTISTATE LICENSE WITH BARTON ASSOCIATES

USE THIS CHECKLIST TO DETERMINE WHETHER YOU QUALIFY FOR THE IMLC METHOD OF LICENSURE:

- You hold a full, unrestricted medical license in a Compact Member State, AND at least one of the below qualifications applies:
 - Your primary residence is in the State of Principal Licensure (SPL).
 - At least 25 percent of your practice of medicine occurred in the SPL over the past 365 days. This also applies to locum tenens providers.
 - Your employer is located in the SPL. For locum tenens providers, this means the facility at which you are assigned is located in the SPL.
 - You use the SPL as your state of residence for U.S. federal income tax purposes.
- You have graduated from an accredited medical school, or a school listed in the International Medical Education Directory.
- You have successfully completed your ACGME- or AOA-accredited graduate medical education.
- You passed each component of the USMLE, COMLEX-USA, or equivalent in no more than three attempts.
- You hold a current specialty certification or time-unlimited certification by an ABMS or AOABOS board.
- You do not have any disciplinary actions toward your medical license(s).
- You do not have any criminal history.
- You do not have any controlled substance actions toward your license(s).
- You are not currently under investigation.
